Then Hollycombe kindly invited us to hold our event at their Museum. It is a pity it is not further North but it is not as far South at our 50<sup>th</sup> was at Beaulieu!!

**Entry vehicles** can arrive from Friday 10<sup>th</sup> August afternoon 2.00- 5.00 p.m. and camping will be available from Friday pm until Monday morning. Free entry to the Museum for two adults plus two children with an entry vehicle plus free camping. Entry vehicles to arrive by 10.30 a.m. on Saturday/Sunday.

On the Saturday evening we will be having a "barbecue" plus buffet and general "get together" in the 80-seater room with undercover overflow if required on what will no doubt be a pleasant summer August evening. There will be a small charge of £5 per head for this with the Society subsidising the full cost – but please bring your own drinks –(plastic glasses only). The steam fairground will be working in the early evening until we are ready to eat from about 7.30 p.m.

If you wish to attend as a Society Member but without an Entry Vehicle, camping is available for you at just £10 for the weekend plus two adults and two children wristbands available at a reduced rate and as a member you are very welcome to attend the Saturday evening event, as are Members who just come for the day on Saturday .YOU MUST BOOK CAMPING/ AND OR MEAL AND PAY IN ADVANCE. Hollycombe Working Steam Museum offers an Edwardian Fairground, a lengthy narrow gauge Steam Railway around the site, Listed woodland gardens, panoramic views, steam engines and fairground organs. Their cafeteria serves hot food and drinks, and there is a gift shop. As they are also a registered charity it is good that we are able to support them.

After our event you may leave either Sunday afternoon or stay over until the Monday morning for a relaxed journey home. We have also been offered the opportunity for vehicles on their way to the Great Dorset Steam Fair to be left at the Museum (at owner's risk) by prior arrangement.

As a Society Member if you no longer own a commercial vehicle but have a "vintage" car or motorbike (pre-1966) you are very welcome to enter it. Please use the Vehicle Entry Form (limited availability).
