CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- The entry must be clean, complete and in a safe working condition, and must show a current VED disc.
- The entry must have a current MOT certificate (unless exempt) and be insured against third party risks for road use. The Society reserves the right to ask for proof of these items. Running on trade plates is not permitted.
- The owner(s) must ensure that all drivers are lawfully qualified to handle the class of vehicle exhibited.
- Steam-driven vehicles will be admitted only if the drivers can show proof of boiler insurance and annual inspection to the organisers.
- An unattended vehicle must be securely braked and/or chocked, and not left with the engine running.
- The owner(s) of the vehicle may be held responsible for any weight damage caused by negligence whilst taking part in the event.
- A speed limit of 10 mph shall apply to all vehicles - including modern tender vehicles - in all rally areas off the highway.
- Competitors must pay full regard to marshals' instructions and conduct themselves in a manner that will not inconvenience other road users or cause annoyance to other persons at any time.
- A substitute entry will be permitted only by prior arrangement with the Run Co-ordinator.
- **No vehicle will be allowed to leave the arena during the presentation of trophies, unless by prior arrangement.**

29. PLEASE READ, THEN SIGN THE DECLARATION

I have read the conditions of entry printed above and agree to be bound by them.

If selected to take part in the Run, I declare that during the whole period of the rally, my entry will be covered by a motor insurance policy which includes rally use, having unlimited liability as required under the road traffic acts for motor vehicles. *The HCVS as the event organiser have their own separate public liability policy for the event, which is independent of the entrants' cover.*

I confirm that every driver of the vehicle entered holds a full licence of the appropriate class to drive that vehicle.
